## **Nominations**

Any member in good standing <u>MUST</u> nominate himself/herself in writing. Such nomination must be addressed to the <u>Election Committee</u> and mailed to P.O. Box 462, McAdenville, NC 28101. on or before May 15, 2020. Such nomination must be sent via certified mail with return receipt. The nominating letter MUST include an <u>email address</u> that will be used to share information with the candidate and will allow the committee to verify that information received via email in fact came from the candidate.

\*\*\*THERE WILL BE NO IN PERSON NOMINATIONS AT A UNION MEETING. ALL NOMINATIONS WILL BE SELF-NOMINATED AND BY MAIL. ONLY A CANDIDATE CAN NOIMINATE THEMSELVES, MEMBERS MAY NOT NOMINATE A CANDIDATE THROUGH THIS PROCESS.

### **Eligibility to Hold Office**

As provided in Article VIII of the Local Constitution, to be eligible for nomination to any elective office of the Local APWU, the candidate must be a member in good standing for a period of one year, provided they have not acted or applied for any supervisory positions with the USPS for at least two years.

### **Voter Eligibility**

All members in good standing by May 1, 2020 will be eligible to vote in this election
