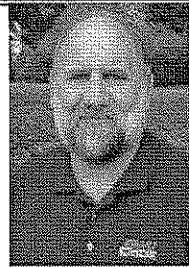

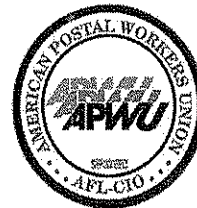

Management has recently informed the local of numerous proposed changes. Two of the changes deal with the movement of the distribution operations from Northeast to North Tryon and Arrowood to Steel Creek. We continue to have discussions with management regarding these changes and will keep the members in these offices updated.

Changes have also been proposed for the P&DC, specifically on tour 3. Management intends to compress the tour 3 hours. They are proposing two automation start times which would be 3:30pm and 5:00pm.

Management plans to have one FSM start time of 1:45pm and is looking at

the caller service and registry room to eliminate positions. They have also proposed that the manual section hours be changed to an 8:00 pm start time.

These are drastic changes and so far our conversations about these changes have been limited. I expect that we will have numerous discussions and we will meet with effected employees prior to management implementing any changes.

The union will make sure that management complies with the CBA and provisions of the LMOU. I will post updates as they are received, but please remember that information posted may change based on our discussions with management.

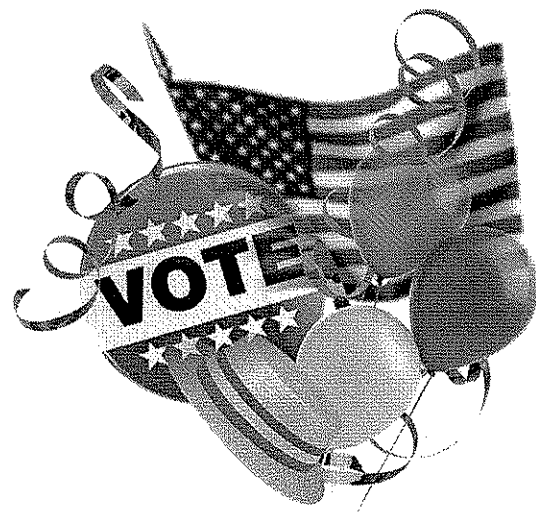

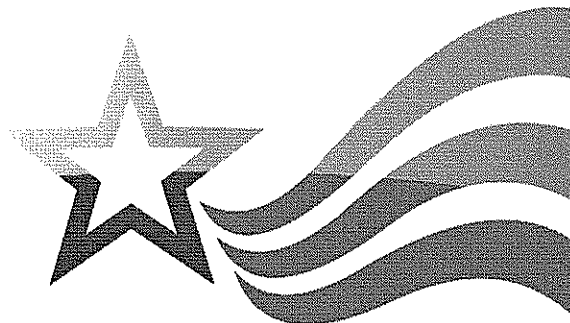

APPEAL C09-017 DENIED

At the 2010 national convention the delegates in attendance upheld the decision of the National Executive Board and rejected the appeal of Genetha Steele which was filed against me.

The National Appeals Committee wrote:
" Therefore, it is the recommendation of the Appeals Committee that the decision of the National Executive Board to uphold the Local Administrating Officer's decision to dismiss the charges and their conclusion that the charging party failed to submit sufficient evidence to support the charges, should be sustained".

This decision ends fourteen months of charges and appeals on the exact same issue that had been previously resolved at the 2008 national convention.

I am very pleased with the decision of the delegates in attendance in Detroit and will continue to serve the membership and concentrate on the important issues facing our members.
